### **Icebreaker**

Share your experience of praying for someone who does not know God. What doors did God open this week with that person?

### **Putting a Priority on People and Living in 3D**

- Read John 4:1-42 - The story of Jesus and the Samaritan Woman.
  - How does this story demonstrate the idea of **Putting a Priority on People** and their potential?
  - How does this story demonstrate the idea of **Living in 3D** (Develop Friendships, Discover Stories, Determine Next Steps)?
- What are the connecting points or environments in your life where you come in contact with **people** who are far from God? If you don't have any, what could you do to create them?
- Who are the **people** in those environments that you are currently overlooking that you could potentially start developing a friendship with?
- What are some of the "filters" you have that prevent you from developing a friendship with some of these **people**? i.e. What prejudices, pre-conceived notions, animosities, assumptions, anger, or sin do you have to look past in order to develop a friendship?
- Spend some time in prayer regarding your answers to the above question. *This may need to include a time of confession, repentance, and request for forgiveness.*

**Challenge:** Make a commitment to begin praying for God to open up doors for you to begin a friendship with this person.
